HISTORY:

Volga is a city in Brookings County, South Dakota, United States. Volga was founded by the Western Town Lot Company on December 27, 1879 by Col. Arthur Jacoby. It was originally named "Bandy Town" after the Bandy family, early settlers there. Later, the railroad assigned it the name "Volga" not after the Volga River, as some believe, but after the Iowa town of the same name.

Schools:

Volga has a small public school system. Sioux Valley Schools has an Elementary, Middle School and High School. Three communities are included in the Sioux Valley school system: Bruce, Sinai, and Volga. www.svs.k12.sd.us

Volga also has a private K through 8th school called the Volga Christian School. www.volgachristianschool.org

First Lutheran Church of Volga offers a non-denominational preschool. Classes are available for children ages three, four and five.



- Business and industry is vital and remains strong in Volga. Steady growth today is a strong indicator for future success.
- Volga City Park, located along Samara Avenue, features picnic shelters, a volleyball court, a disc golf course, horse-shoe pits, playground equipment and a swimming pool.
- The Brookings County Museum, located at the Volga City Park, showcases history from the early days of settlement in the area. Included in the museum are an 1870 log cabin, vintage farm equipment with an antique tool room, and a one-room country school house.
- Meadow Creek Golf Course features natural prairie and wetlands within its challenging 9-hole course. This popular course is open to the public.
- Our Summer Recreation Youth Program is filled with opportunities for children of all ages and interests.
- Friday night roller skating is a tradition in Volga. Come join us!
